Neurodevelopmental Therapy – Benefit Change Effective January 1, 2006**

This is a summary of material modification describing recent benefit changes adopted by the Board of Trustees. Please be sure that you and your family read it carefully. Keep this important notice with your January 2006 Summary Plan Description booklet.

The Board of Trustees has modified the Neurodevelopmental Therapy benefit, as described below, to increase the lifetime maximum from \$2,000 to \$5,000. This change is effective for services rendered on and after January 1, 2006:

NEURODEVELOPMENTAL THERAPY

Effective January 1, 2006, the plan will cover Neurodevelopmental Therapy up to a lifetime maximum of \$5,000 for children age 6 and under to improve various physical and mental functions or when significant deterioration in the child's condition would result without these services. Therapy may be from a physician or physical, occupational, or speech therapist.
