RE: Dental Benefit Changes

This is a summary of material modification describing benefit changes adopted by the Board of Trustees. Please be sure that you and your family read it carefully and keep this document with your Summary Plan Description Booklet.

The Board of Trustees took action to adopt new language (*italicised below*) with regard to dental exam benefits effective February 1, 2011 as follows:

<p><u>Limitations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prophylaxis including periodontal cleaning is covered up to four times per calendar year • Topical application of fluoride is covered once in a 6-month period when performed in conjunction with prophylaxis, up to the patient’s 19th birthday • Fissure sealants are available for children up to age 14. Payment for application of sealants will be for permanent maxillary (upper) or mandibular (lower) molars with incipient or no carried (decay), on an intact occlusal surface. The application of fissure sealants is a covered benefit only once in 3 calendar years per tooth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prophylaxis <i>once in a 6-month period</i> • <i>Periodontal maintenance is limited to one treatment within any 3-month period. Prophylaxis is in addition to periodontal maintenance</i> • Topical application of fluoride is covered once in a 6-month period when performed in conjunction with prophylaxis, up to the patient’s 19th birthday • Fissure sealants are available for children up to age 14. Payment for application of sealants will be for permanent maxillary (upper) or mandibular (lower) molars with incipient or no carried (decay), on an intact occlusal surface.
